### **EVENT DETAILS**

### **Event Description**

Corporate Cycling (Aust) is hosting CX Ballarat from Friday, 18 August to Sunday, 20 August 2023, at Victoria Park, Ballarat. This will be the AusCycling Cyclo-Cross National and Victorian State Championships and therefore will be conducted under the guidance of the UCI and AusCycling Technical Regulations.

### **Course Location & Maps:**

The course is ~2.55k, 95% grass and dirt, and includes a short but steep climbs at the midway point; at the 'Mound' Course maps can be found in Appendix B, and via the event's website.

## **COMPETITOR INFORMATION**

### **Technical Regulations**

The event will be conducted under the UCI Cyclo-cross Regulations and AusCycling Technical Regulations both General and Cyclo-Cross specific. This includes regulations on start areas, call-ups, race duration, pit areas, equipment and any other technical information not outlined in this document.

### Registration

Riders enter the event via the event's website. aOn-the-day entries will also be taken during the operating hours of the on-site registration. The operation hours of registration are outlined in the Event Schedule (See Appendix A) and via the event's website. Registration will also be utilised for the distribution of Rider Packs.

Under 23 (MU & WU) (19-22 years old) categories will be included in the 2023 AusCycling Cyclo-Cross National Championships. For Series rounds that offer an U23 category, points will be awarded and combined to the participants Under 23 National Championships point score.

Participants may qualify for both an Elite ranking and Age-Group ranking for the National Championships year if they have competed in each category.

U23 or Masters riders may elect to race in the Elite category for any event however they will only earn Series points in the Elite category from those events where the individual raced in the Elite category. Points accumulated from non-elite categories do not count towards Elite Series points.

Categories may be combined for race starts, in accordance with the AusCycling Technical Regulations but are to be awarded separately (Masters 1-3, Master 4+ etc).

#### **Prizes**

National Champion jerseys and medals will be awarded for the National Championships. Medals will be awarded for the Victorian State Cyclo-Cross Championships.

#### **Presentations**

Presentation ceremonies will take place at the event village in Victoria Park as per the event schedule.

All riders who finish 1st to 5th in elite, and 1st to 3rd in all other categories, must be present at the presentation.

#### First Aid/Medical Services

Professional medical services will be provided throughout the event and during course practice on Friday. The medical team will be onsite from village opening to village close.

### **Race Timing**

The event will be timed and recorded by Tomato Timing. Results will be displayed and publicised via the event website.

Riders may keep race numbers; shoulder and jersey numbers (dossards). Ankle-worn timing transponders MUST be returned at the end of riders' racing.

### **Anti-Doping Testing**

All competitors may be subject to anti-doping testing under AusCycling and Sport Integrity Australia regulations. If you are an elite rider, you must apply for a pre-event TUE.

#### **Team Tents**

Teams are encouraged to have an active professional presence and promote their commercial partners.

Team tents provisions is as follows;

- An allocated team tent zone is marked out in the event village per site plan.
- Please check in with the event organisers prior to set up.
- Please be considerate of others in set up and infrastructure (e.g., consider noise levels)

#### Bump in times are;

- 15:00 18:00 Friday, 18 August 2023
- 7:00 8:30 Saturday, 19 August 2023
- 7:00 8:30 Sunday, 20 August 2023

Overnight security is provided, and tents may be left in place however we recommend taking any valuables with you.

- No car parking provision at team tents area
- It is important that marquees are properly secured. Please remove any roof or wall overnight in the event of high winds.

### **Media and Marketing**

As the AusCycling National Cyclo-Cross Championships, CX Ballarat is expected to attract strong cycling and local media interest. CX Ballarat and AusCycling are also actively marketing and promoting CX Ballarat and encourage everyone involved to do the same.

- There is an official photographer for the event. Imagery will be shared post event.
